

Disaster Area Cancellation Moratorium
Effective: July 12, 2017 – September 30, 2017

The governor of Illinois has declared four counties as state disaster areas due to issues related to recent flooding. On July 17, 2017, the Illinois Department of Insurance declared a moratorium on policy cancellations and nonrenewals from July 12, 2017 through September 30, 2017, for **Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry counties.**

If either you or your property has been affected by the flooding in one of these counties, your policy will not be cancelled or nonrenewed during the moratorium period.

Also, any actions on your part (such as tendering a claim or submitting a proof of loss) required under the policy will be granted a 60-day extension from the original deadline.
